Welcome: Hubert Etchison, President, College Hill Neighborhood Association, and Joan Dean, President, League of Women Voters of Northampton County.

Moderator: Dr. Phyllis Finger (explanation of format). Moderator will pose questions to candidates in a consistent, fair, and unbiased manner.

Candidates: Opening statements (2 minutes each). Will speak in ballot order.

Questions: Candidates will respond to questions submitted in writing by CHNA members, LWV members, and audience in attendance. Questions may be addressed to a specific candidate or to all three candidates. Candidates' responses will be made on a rotating basis. Candidates will have 2 minutes to complete their responses. When a question is posed to a specific candidate, the other candidates may respond/comment for 1 minute each.

Timekeeper: LWV representatives will keep the official time for candidate responses and comments.

Closing Remarks: Each candidate will have 2 minutes to offer closing remarks. Candidates will be called in reverse ballot order.

Other: The forum will be limited to 1 hour. At the conclusion of the program, there will be a 30-minute period for light refreshments and mingling.
