Article II - Membership

Geographic Exceptions – The Membership Committee may at its discretion recommend for approval by the Executive Committee prospective members who live outside of the existing geography of College Hill as stated in Sections 1 and 2, provided that the rationale for this exception meets at least two of the following criteria:

- 1) Prospective member is a past member with CHNA and wishes to continue to be a member despite living a reasonable distance outside our geographic area;
- 2) Prospective member has on-going ties to the College Hill community despite living a reasonable distance from our geographic area; and/or
- 3) Proposed member's membership would result in a mutually beneficial relationship between the proposed member and CHNA without violating our Conflict of Interest policy.

The executive committee vote for approval must be by a simple majority.
